You will receive a confirmation of the receipt of your manuscript as soon as possible as well as an indication of the period needed for the assessment of your manuscript. The final decision about the acceptance of manuscripts in the series is taken by the editorial board, on the basis of a detailed proposal by the series' editors. After acceptance your manuscript will, if necessary, be made camera ready by Ingeborg Löwisch, the editorial assistant of the series. For every volume a separate contract will be made between the publisher, Brill, and the author(s)/editor(s) of the manuscript.

English manuscripts should be prepared according to *The Chicago Manual of Style*. *The Chicago Manual of Style* is available on the internet (<http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org>) as well as both in print: *The Chicago Manual of Style*, fourteenth edition (Chicago-London: The University of Chicago Press, 1993) [A fifteenth edition of *CMS* is now also available; both editions may be used] and on CD-Rom: *The Chicago Manual of Style, 15th edition CD-ROM (The University of Chicago, 2006)*. For German manuscripts or German-English ones a style sheet is available that offers an adaptation of the SBL style, which bases on the *Chicago Manual of Style* and should be acceptable to German readers ([GermanStyle.pdf](#)). Please prepare your manuscript according to these guidelines and use for the format of all documents involved the template of the series (available on the Noster website). In case you intend to use another style or template, please consult the chief editor in advance.
